



**KTH Industriell teknik

Stockholm International Airport, Arlanda, is situated 44 kilometres north of Stockholm. When you are at Arlanda airport, you can either take bus or train to the city center "City Terminalen".

You can take the buses "Flygbussarna" just outside the airport building to the Stockholm city. You can buy the ticket online, in the arriving hall or in the bus. It takes about 40 minutes to reach the city center by bus and the costs are 99 SEK for a single and 179 SEK for a double ticket .

You can also take the fast train "Arlanda Express" at the underground level of the airport building. It departs every 15 minutes from Arlanda to Stockholm Central Station. At Arlanda Airport, there are two stations for Arlanda Express. One station with entrances in Terminal 2, 3 and 4, and the other with entrance in Terminal 5. You can buy the ticket inside at the airport building only. It takes about 20 minutes to reach the city center by train and the costs are 220 SEK for a single and 420 SEK for a double ticket.

If you want to take taxi, it will cost around 400 - 450 SEK from Arlanda airport to city center. Different taxies have different prices, it is common practice to ask the price if you do not want to be surprised at the end of the journey !

You arrive to city center and enter the building of central station, you will find the metro "TunnelBana" at the underground level of the building. The sign for metro in Sweden is a "T" inside a circle. You can find the information about the inner city bus and metro timetables online. You will take the red-line metro route towards "Mörby Centrum" and will go down at "Tekniska Högskolan" stop "3rd Stop". It is important to pay attention to the direction "Mörby Centrum" since almost every second train in the same line goes to "Ropsten" which is totally a different direction.
